

Leitstelle Proxy App Configuration Crash Recovery System (CRS)

Introduction

In Germany only German number plates can be requested from a dispatch centres (Leistelle) premise to the KBA (national vehicle register of Germany). A fire fighter on the scene of an accident is not allowed to make a direct number plate request. To by-pass this restriction, the dispatch centre can install the CRSLeitstelleProxy WebApi in it's premise. Because the proxy is hosted in the premise of the dispatch centre and number plate request is sent from this location, it is allowed to make connection to the KBA. The device of the fire fighter has to be configured to make connection to this proxy. The proxy has to be public accessible for the fire fighter of the dispatch centre.



How to set the URL in the CRS


Note: the example shows how to set the URL in the CRS.Windows desktop application, but the procedure should be the same for the CRS.Mobile apps (Android and iOS).

Note: the settings only apply for the RDW(+) and VIN Editions.

In the Main Menu of the application, click on the 'Settings' button in the right upper corner.




In the CRS Management menu, click on Preferences.



In the Preferences, at 'Vehicle Selection Options'-section set the 'Default country numberplate / VIN selection' to Germany if necessary.

Next, expand 'Advanced Settings' and scroll down to 'Dispatch Center Portal'-section. Enter the details of the connection to the CRSLeitstelleProxy. Make sure the last character of the name of the API ends with the character '/'.
